### PAYMENT SCHEDULE(Applies only to "Performance Only" and "Commuter Packages")

- REGISTRATION FEES** are due with Festival application. **REGISTRATION FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.**  
Registration fees--\$225.00 first group, and \$150.00 for each additional group  
Payments should be made to "Texas Music Festivals, LLC."
- FESTIVAL FEES**-Schools will be invoiced according to number of "estimated" students (Registration Form, page 2) attending the festival. Full payment is due 15 days prior to the festival. In order to receive the refund, a **Final Count** of students participating must be received by Texas Music Festivals, LLC, in writing, by midnight, Friday one (1) week prior to the festival. Notification may be made either by U.S. mail or fax. Refunds will be mailed to the school after the Festival.
- FAILURE TO PAY**-TMF reserves the right to withhold any and all services should the school fail to make payments according to the schedule listed above. Final adjustments can be made the day of the festival.
- CANCELLATION**-All payments (+tax or tax exempt form) must be made in \$USD. All reservations are subject to cancellation by TMF or suppliers, without refund of any deposit, if payments are not received by due dates. TMF assumes no responsibility in the event of reservations canceled by supplier's for non-payment of monies due.

### ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- Program arrangement: Texas Music Festivals, LLC, (TMF) is responsible for making arrangements for all services included in the Festival Package ("Package"). Each participant shall be financially responsible for any expenses incurred not specifically listed in the "Package". These items include, but are not limited to transportation service, telephone calls, meals not specifically listed in the package and personal expenses and damages. The Director, who shall be appointed by the school, Advisers and Chaperones shall be responsible for students, participation in all program activities. TMF assumes no responsibility for any participant when absent from TMF-supervised activities.
- Release: By registering for the festival or program, the school agrees to indemnify and hold harmless TMF, Schlitterbahn, Six Flags, Fiesta Texas, The "Zone", and its officers, directors, employees and agents from any financial liability or obligation incurred by either the school, or any individual participants, and from and injury or damage to the person or property of others which any participant causes, or contributes to, while participating in a TMF program. Each participant hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless TMF, The "Zone", Fiesta Texas, and Schlitterbahn and its officers, directors, employees and agents from any financial liability or obligation incurred by that individual participant and from any injury or damage to the person or property of others which that participant causes, or contributes to, while participating in an TMF program. The school, by submitting the application, releases TMF, The "Zone", Fiesta Texas, and Schlitterbahn, its officers, directors, employees and agents from any and all causes of actions, claims and damages of any kind, or nature, whatsoever, arising from any injury, loss, damage, cost, accident, delay, irregularity, or expense arising out of, or in any way connected with the performance or operation of an TMF program.
- Events beyond the control of TMF: TMF shall not be responsible for events beyond its control such as, without limitation, acts of God, strikes or government restrictions, or for acts or omissions of persons or companies not controlled by it such as, without limitation, air carriers, motor coach companies, rail companies, hotels, attractions, or other suppliers. The school agrees to indemnify and hold harmless TMF, The "Zone", Schlitterbahn, Six Flags, its officers, directors, employees and agents, from all claims arising out of such events, acts or omissions.
- Health and Safety Measures: TMF shall reserve the right, but not the duty, to take whatever action it deems necessary in regard to the health and safety of any, or all, participants including, without limitation, obtaining medical treatment on their behalf and transporting them at their own expense to their home for medical or other emergency reasons. In addition, it shall be the responsibility of the Director and/or Chaperone to be present at all times should a participant who is ill need to be confined to a hospital.
- Rules and Standards of Conduct: TMF shall reserve the right to implement, and enforce, what ever reasonable rules and standards of conduct it may deem necessary, without prior approval, to insure and maintain a proper program atmosphere. Such rules may include, without limitation, rules regarding appropriate dress and use of vulgar language and smoking. TMF further reserves the right to terminate the participation of any individual who fails to comply with any such rules and return them home at their expense with no refund of program from TMF.
- Alcoholic Beverages and Illegal Drugs: TMF observes a strict policy of ZERO TOLERANCE in regard to alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs. Participants under the age of twenty-one (21) are forbidden to use, or have in their possession, alcoholic beverages of any kind. All participants, regardless of age, are forbidden to use, or have in their possession, illegal or narcotic drugs, except those prescribed by a licensed physician. Possession of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs is grounds for immediate dismissal of the participant's, immediate return home at their expense without refund, and notification of law enforcement officials, if deemed appropriate by TMF.
